The Institution has conducted an online survey among the students to collect feedbacks from them . It has designed a proforma to collect and analyze students views which would be used as feedback from students. The following bullets summaries how the students view about their institution and teachers and other employees and the facilities they get.

- 84% students are satisfied with the teaching method of the teachers and cover up of the syllabus. And 16 percent students demanded more efficiency in teachers.
- 65% students satisfied with facilities provided in the institution and 25% exposed their discontentment over it and 10% students remained neutral.
- > 86% of the students like CBCS and semester examination where as 14% students preferred to early examination systems.
- 90% students like a fair oral evolution system where as 10% view online mode of evaluation systems.
- 79% students like the campus saying as very peaceful but 21% students demanded a well furnished WiFi- availed campus for them.
- > Every time students praised the campus saying peaceful and friendly
